Board of Control

- 1. The Board of Control recommends Council authorize a purchase order to Earl George in the amount of \$11,000.00 for a 2006 John Deere 3203 Compact Utility Tractor with front end loader, tiller, and post digger for the Park. This expense will be charged to the Capital Improvement Fund Park and is in the 2018 budget (see attached). VOTE: 3-0
- 2. The Board of Control recommends Council authorize a purchase order to Environmental Engineering Service in the amount not to exceed \$14,500.00 to perform the local limits study for the Industrial Pretreatment Program. This expense will be charged to the Sewer Fund and is in the 2018 budget. VOTE: 3-0
- 3. The Board of Control recommends Council authorize a purchase order to Software Solutions in the amount of \$18,540.00 for the annual software license and maintenance support for the various modules used in the Finance Department. This year's amount is a 5% increase over 2017. This expense will be charged equally to Finance Accounting, Utility Billing and Income Tax and is in the 2018 budget at \$18,000.00. VOTE: 3-0
- Footnote #1 During the week of July 2nd, the Roof Top Unit #4 that provides heating & cooling to the Municipal Court Area froze up. Since it was installed with the building project in the 1990's, the city planned on replacing the RTU this year and budgeted \$12,000.00 in the 2018 budget. On July 10, 2018 the Board of Control approved an emergency purchase order to

Reliant Mechanical Inc. in the amount of \$ 14,066.00 for material and labor to replace Roof Top Unit #4 located over the Municipal Court area. This will be charged to Capital Improvement Fund - Administration and is in the 2018 budget at \$12,000.00.

Footnote #2: - On July 8th, the Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) located at Well #9 blew up. The contractor came out and verified that it needs replaced. The VFD is a necessary component to operate the water wells. On July 11, 2018, the Board of Control approved an emergency purchase order to Rabenstein Electric in the amount of \$8,000.00 for all parts and labor to replace the VFD at Well #9. This will be charged to the Water Fund and is in the 2018 budget.

Footnote #3 - On June 15, 2018 the Oakdale Cemetery Board approved the release of the first installment of \$2,900.00 to Mike Major Sculpture Ltd. from the Cemetery Improvement Fund to begin the Indian Hunter Project. This project is funded by private donations.
