Attention Food Truck Vendor:

The Urbana Division of Fire has produced this letter to help you make certain that your truck is compliant with the Ohio Fire Code. Below is a list of items that you may utilize as a checklist to ensure your truck will pass inspection. This list is not all inclusive, but it is what the Fire Division feels is most important as it relates to the fire code.

- Proper size and type of fire extinguisher that has been serviced complete with service tag within
 the last 12 months. A Class K extinguisher is also required for any solid fuels or vegetable or
 animal oils and fats being used to cook.
- Inspection tags on any suppression devices located in your truck.
- Propane cylinders need to be secured so that they will not fall over in the event that they are collided with.
- No electrical hazards. Examples to include but not limited to; excess usage of extension cords, multi-plug adapters, daisy chaining surge protectors, open electrical boxes, bare or uncapped energized wires, excessively worn electrical cords.
- Combustible storage and supplies shall not be kept near the cooking appliances.
- Must have "no smoking" signs conspicuously posted inside and out.
- Carbon Monoxide detectors must be present and in working order. ONLY exemption is hand propelled carts.

Thank you for your diligence and responsible outlook on adhering to the fire code, subsequently creating a safe environment for our community when your truck is present.
