

# URBANA CORRIDOR DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS

## D. SIGNS

Effective 1-1-2013

(Excerpt)

### SPECIAL & COMMUNITY EVENTS SIGN

#### 1. Special & Community Events Sign:

- a. All events sponsored or supported by a public or private organization which are open to the general public; are educational, cultural, or recreational in function; and are offered as such for a limited period of time.

#### 2. Signs in Private Yards

The following shall be permitted in private yards outright:

- a. Temporary signs promoting a special and community event in private yards with the following conditions:
  - i. Only one (1) sign is allowed per parcel.
  - ii. Signs shall not exceed four (4) square.
  - iii. These signs may be placed up to fifteen (15) days in advance and must be removed within forty-eight (48) hours following the event.

#### 3. Signs in Right-of-Way

The following shall be permitted in certain designated areas of right-of-way upon the completion of a Special Event Request Form containing the signed authorization of the Director of Administration:

- a. Festival banners on public property are permitted in certain designated areas without fee by any group or individual complying with the following conditions:
  - i. Banners shall be placed on a first-come basis, by the City Street Superintendent.
  - ii. The banner may remain in place for up to fifteen (15) days.
  - iii. Banner requirements are as follows:
    - 1) Maximum size of the banner is sixty (60) square feet.
    - 2) Banner material must be such that it will not fade, tear, or become un-presentable, or aesthetically displeasing.
  - iv. By processing a permit for a banner, the applicant agrees to hold the City harmless from any and all risks, liability costs, claims, or causes of action that may arise from the placement of any banner. Such assumption of risk and hold harmless is a material condition of the use of the public property for banner placement.
- b. Ground-mounted temporary signs may be permitted in certain designated areas without fee by any group or individual complying with the following conditions:
  - i. These signs may be placed up to fifteen (15) days in advance and must be removed within forty-eight (48) hours following the event.
  - ii. By processing a permit for a ground-mounted temporary sign, the applicant agrees to hold the City harmless from any and all risks, liability costs, claims, or causes of action that may arise from the placement of any banner. Such assumption of risk and hold harmless is a material condition of the use of the public property for banner placement.
  - iii. Unauthorized temporary signs shall be removed.
