Request For Qualifications/Proposal
For Lead-Based Paint Risk Assessment Services

The City of Urbana is seeking a qualified consultant/agency to provide lead-based paint risk assessment and clearance testing services for the City's FY 2013 CHIP Grant Program. Urbana is requesting a Statement of Qualifications and Proposal for Professional Services from qualified consulting firms, organizations, or individuals for the purpose of providing licensed lead risk assessment and certified clearance-testing services.

The City's CHIP program is expected to include Home Repair, Private-Owner Rehab and/or similar housing activities which may require lead risk assessments. It is not known how many units will need risk assessments and clearance testing at this time.

Urbana's goal is to have a Risk Assessor available to contact when needed to determine the presence of lead-based paint hazards and to establish appropriate Abatement and Interim Controls. It is estimated the construction work items will be between \$5,000 and \$35,000 per unit, and will require lead-safe Renovation, Remodeling and Rehabilitation and/or Abatement.
