INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids for construction of the City of Urbana Wastewater Facility Improvements Project Rebid will be received by the City at the office of the Finance Director, City of Urbana, City Building – 205 South Main Street, Urbana, OH 43078, until 11:00 AM, July 2, 2013 and at that time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Contract Documents may be examined and/or obtained at the office of CDM Smith Inc., 8800 Lyra Drive, Columbus, OH 43240 and at Key Blue Prints Inc, 6180 Cleveland Ave., Columbus, OH 43231. A bidders list will be maintained by Key Blue Prints and published on their web site [www.keycompanies.com](http://www.keycompanies.com).

A deposit of \$450.00 in cash, bank or certified check payable to CDM Smith will be required for each set of the Contract Documents. This is a rebid of the same project that had bids opened on April 23, 2013 therefore any Plan Holder who paid for the original set of documents will be provided a free set of plans for this rebid.

Bidders requesting Contract Documents by mail shall include an additional nonrefundable check payable to CDM Smith Inc. in the amount of \$50.00 per set to cover costs of handling and mailing or a UPS or FedEx charge number.

Engineers Estimate for this project is \$20,500,000.00.

Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of 10 percent of the Bid.

Bidders may not withdraw their Bids 60 days after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.

Bids shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid amount or by certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the bid, subject to conditions provided in Instructions to bidders. The Successful Bidder shall be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

No Pre-bid meeting will be held.

The wage rates are subject to the minimum wage rates as required by the Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Rates.
