

## Public Notice Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of the City Engineer of the City of Urbana, 205 South Main Street, Urbana, Ohio 43078, until 1:00PM local time, April 1, 2014, to furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as "Phase 1 Water Replacement", and at said time and place, be publicly opened and read aloud. This project encompasses the abandonment and replacement of deteriorating 4" and 6" water mains on E. Ward Street, E. Church Street, and E. Court Street from N. Main Street to N. Jefferson Avenue with new 8" PVC water main. Existing water lines on connector streets will be replaced with new 4" PVC water main. Full street paving and replacement curb, gutter and sidewalk are included for repairs.

Engineer's Estimate: \$2,830,000.00

The proposals shall be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents or a copy thereof and shall contain the full name and address of the bidder. All bids shall be sealed and plainly marked "Phase 1 Water Replacement".

Bids shall be submitted in **duplicate**, signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond issued in favor of the City of Urbana, Ohio in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in favor of the City of Urbana, Ohio in the amount of 100% of the Bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Each Bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Bid and all persons interested therein. Each Bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner anticipates that construction will begin in June of 2014 and requires that this project be substantially completed by November 6, 2015.

Copies of the bid documents and specifications are on file in the office of the City Engineer, 205 South Main Street, Urbana, Ohio 43078, where they may be obtained for a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit for each set of these documents.

Each prospective bidder shall be a plan holder of record with the City of Urbana Engineer's Office in order to submit a bid for this project.

Any contract(s) awarded under this Invitation to Bid are expected to be funded with financial assistance from the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation to Bid or any resulting contract. This procurement will be

subject to regulations contained in 40 CFR Part 33.

Bidders shall be required to comply with 40 CFR Part 33.240 of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Region 5 policy on the increased utilization of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE). The requirements for bidders and contractors covered by this policy are explained in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall be required to comply with President's Executive Order No. 11246 of September 24, 1965 and any amendments or supplements to that Executive Order. Furthermore, bidders shall be required to complete and submit the Equal Employment Opportunity Certification with their bid.

Bidders shall be required to review, complete, certify, and submit the Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Other Responsibility Matters with their bid.

Bidders shall be required to comply with the Davis-Bacon Act and all applicable provisions of the federal prevailing wage laws. Furthermore, bidders shall be subject to all applicable Federal Equal Employment Opportunity laws and Federal Labor Standards. Bidders shall comply with the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act.

Bidders shall comply with the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).

Bidders shall comply with all applicable standards, orders, or requirements under Section 306 of the Clean Air Act, 42 USC 1857 (h), Section 508 of the Clean Water Act, 33 USC 1368, Executive Order 11738, and EPA regulations, 40 CFR Part 32, which prohibits the use under non-exempt Federal contracts, grants, or loans of facilities included on the EPA List of Violating Facilities.

In accordance with H.R. 3547, bidders on this project shall be required to complete this construction project using only iron and steel produced in the United States unless a waiver is provided to the Owner by the EPA. EPA's directive under H.R. 3547, Div. G Title IV provides instructions for implementing this requirement.

A valid workers' compensation certificate and a valid certificate of insurance shall be provided upon contract award to the successful bidder.

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive irregularities in any Bid and to accept any Bid which is deemed by the Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
