

**Public Notice
Advertisement for Bids**

Sealed bids will be received on behalf of the Champaign County Commissioners and the City of Urbana at the Office of the City Engineer of the City of Urbana, 205 South Main Street, Urbana, Ohio 43078, until 10:00AM local time, Tuesday, June 3, 2014, to furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as East US Route 36 Sewer Extension and at said time and place, be publicly opened and read aloud. This cooperative project between the Champaign County Commissioners and the City of Urbana is funded in part by a CDBG Economic Development Public Infrastructure Grant awarded to the Champaign County Commissioners. The balance of the project is funded through City of Urbana Sewer Capital Improvement Funds. This project consists of the installation of 1400' of 8" gravity sewer main; 5,300' of 4" force main; 185' of 10" gravity sewer main; and a pump station.

Engineer's Estimate: \$359,633.00

The proposals shall be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents or a copy thereof and shall contain the full name and address of the bidder. All bids shall be sealed and plainly marked "East US Route 36 Sewer Extension".

Bids shall be submitted in **duplicate**, signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond issued in favor of the Champaign County Commissioners, City of Urbana, Ohio, and the Ohio Department of Transportation in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in favor of the Champaign County Commissioners, City of Urbana, Ohio, and the Ohio Department of Transportation in the amount of 100% of the Bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Furthermore, upon inspection and release of the performance bond, the City of Urbana and the awarded project contractor shall submit a maintenance bond in favor of the Ohio Department of Transportation in the amount of \$125,000. The maintenance bond shall remain in full force for 36 months until final inspection and acceptance of the work by ODOT. At contract award, ODOT will accept a Letter of Assurance signed by the City of Urbana (the permittee) and the awarded project contractor stating that the maintenance bond will be provided at project completion.

Each prospective bidder shall be a plan holder of record with the City of Urbana Engineer's Office in order to submit a bid for this project.

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening thereof. Project completion date shall be October 31, 2014.

This project is funded in part with Community Development Block Grant funds. Therefore, this entire project shall be a prevailing wage contract in accordance with federal Davis-Bacon Wage Laws. Bidders shall comply with all applicable provisions of the federal prevailing wage laws. This project is also subject to all applicable Federal Equal Employment Opportunity laws and Federal Labor Standards.

The Champaign County Commissioners and the City of Urbana, Ohio (Owners) reserve the right to reject any or all bids, waive irregularities in any Bid and to accept any Bid which is deemed by the Owners to be most favorable to the Owners.
