Clarifications

The new vehicle described as a Police Cruiser is not intended to be a fully outfitted Police Cruiser. The goal is to create a stripped down Police Cruiser to be used as a vehicle for police investigators with the capability for the vehicle to be able to respond to emergency situations, including concealed lighting.

The new vehicle described as a Mid-Size Sedan is simply intended to be used as a vehicle for the Police Chief. This vehicle is only the base vehicle as specified with no police equipment or lighting.

Question #1/ Response #1

Q: Can you tell me if you are looking for the bidded equipment to be installed or shipped loose? Bid does not specify.

R: The police equipment is to be fully installed on the vehicle. Where line items on the bid form include police equipment, the price shall include the cost of installation.

Question #2/Response #2

Q: Just for clarification. Installation for the entire vehicle or just what was asked for in the bid?

R: Installation shall be included for all items as specified under Police Cruiser (Equipment) Specifications.

Question #3/Response #3

Q: Will any equipment need to be reused from the old cars? If so, is the removal and re-installation something that is being requested?

R: No equipment is intended to be reused or reinstalled.

Question #4/Response #4

Q: Are both vehicles going to be fully fledged police cruisers and are both vehicles getting the same equipment setup?

R: See clarification above.

Question #5/Response #5

Q: Sound Off Lighting—Does the PD want a full size external light bar or an internal ILS system? Also, is the light bar going to be the only emergency lighting that the PD is wanting to have installed?

R: See updated Police Cruiser (Equipment) Specifications below.

Q: Does the PD have a preference as to which series light bar we quote from Sound Off?

Q: Does the PD have a preference as to which light/siren control box is quoted?
