

## What Can I Recycle?

The following is a list of what items may be placed in your bin for recycling.



### Plastics

Soft Plastic Household Bottles & Jugs, such as:  
▲ Soda Bottles  
▲ Milk/Water Jugs  
▲ Laundry Jugs  
▲ Cleaning Bottles

#### **HOW to Prepare:**

Remove & Discards Lids  
Rinse and Flatten(if possible)

#### **DO Not Recycle:**

Plastic Bags  
Plastic Containers used for Automotive Products, Paints, Solvents, Lawn Care Products & Chemicals.



### Glass

All Colors of Glass Bottles & Jars, such as:  
▲ Juice & Pop Bottles  
▲ Beer & Wine Bottles  
▲ Food Jars

#### **HOW to Prepare:**

Remove & Discards Lids  
Rinse Well

#### **DO Not Recycle:**

Drinking Glasses, Dishes, Mirrors, Window Glass, Light Bulbs & Broken Glass



### Metal

Metal Food & Beverage Containers, such as:  
▲ Food Cans  
▲ Beverage Cans  
▲ Aluminum Foil & Pie Pans  
▲ Aerosol Spray Cans

#### **HOW to Prepare:**

Remove & Discards Lids  
Remove Labels from Food Cans

Rinse Well

#### **DO Not Recycle:**

Cans used for Chemicals or Paint, Appliances, Power Tools, Batteries & Hangers



### Newspaper/Cardboard

▲ Newspaper & Inserts  
▲ Brown Paper Bags  
▲ Drink Boxes, Milk Cartons  
▲ Food Boxes - Cereal Etc  
▲ Phone Books  
▲ Magazines  
▲ Junk Mail & Other Paper  
▲ Corrugated Cardboard\*

#### **HOW to Prepare:**

Place Papers in Paper Bag & Put in the Bottom of the Bin  
*DO Not use plastic bags.*

#### **DO Not Recycle:**

Books, Beverage Cartons & Beer Cases

**If you fill your bin, put extra recycling in an open paper bag beside or on top of the bin.  
If something is left in your bin, it is NOT currently recyclable. Please dispose of these items properly.**
