

Public Open House Notice
Dugan Run Flood Hazard Mapping Update

The City of Urbana (City) has undertaken a project to update the flood hazard mapping for Dugan Run and Dugan Run Tributary A. Flood hazard information that is currently published by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS-FEMA) for these watercourses is based on a watershed study performed in the early 1980's. The City has procured a revised flood hazard analysis based on current accepted methods with updated and higher resolution topographic mapping than the prior study.

Flood hazard mapping for Dugan Run shall be revised from a point approximately 560 feet west of Muzzy's Road to a point approximately 350 feet north of Dellinger Road. Flood hazard mapping for Dugan Run Tributary A shall be revised from the confluence with Dugan Run to Washington Avenue.

Maps and detailed analysis of the flood hazard revision can be reviewed at a public Open House to be held on **Thursday March 15, 2018 from 6pm to 8pm** at the City of Urbana, 205 South Main Street.
