

## **2012-2013 Unit Price Concrete Work Addendum #1**

**Re: Brick Pavers/Removals and Restorations/Statement of Bidder's Qualifications/Insurance**

### **Brick Pavers**

On Page 46, the Brick Pavers section shall be deleted from the bidding documents. Per City Standard 1167.09, cast-in place, engineered plastic/polymer composite detectable warning devices shall be used. Brick pavers are no longer permitted to be used.

### **Removals and Restoration**

On page 45, the Removals and Restoration section shall be revised to include the following: "The contractor shall be responsible for the proper disposal of all stone, concrete, asphalt, dirt, etc. that is removed in the process of completing each assigned work order. All disposal of removal material shall be in strict accordance with local, state, and federal law".

### **Statement of Bidder's Qualifications**

The Statement of Bidder's Qualifications shall be removed from the bid forms for this bid. Pages 32 & 33 do not need to be completed or returned with the bidder's response.

### **Insurance**

The Insurance section on pages 11-13 shall be revised to include: "All coverage shall be written on an occurrence basis".

The bodily injury liability limits, property damage liability limits, and umbrella/excess liability coverage (three separate paragraphs) on page 12 shall be revised to read:

Bodily Injury and Property Damage, Combined Single Limits (CSL) of

- 1) \$1,000,000.00 Each Occurrence
- 2) \$1,000,000.00 General Aggregate
- 3) \$1,000,000.00 Products Completed Aggregate
- 4) \$1,000,000.00 Personal and Advertising Injury Limit

The successful bidder shall procure Umbrella Excess Liability Insurance, with limits of:

- 1) \$1,000,000.00 for each occurrence

The following section shall be added under the insurance requirements for Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance: "The successful bidders shall procure Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance which shall include all owned vehicles, non-owned vehicles and all hired vehicles, naming the City of Urbana, Ohio, as additional insured, with limits of":

- 1) \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limits
