

## Public Notice Advertisement for Bids

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of the City Engineer of the City of Urbana, 205 South Main Street, Urbana, Ohio 43078, until 10:00AM local time, August 6, 2012, to furnish all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the project known as "Phoenix Drive Reconstruction" and at said time and place, be publicly opened and read aloud. The project consists of roadway reconstruction by rubblizing the existing concrete street into sub-base and resurfacing the street with an 8-inch asphalt layer.

Engineer's Estimate: \$219,414.00

The proposals shall be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents or a copy thereof and shall contain the full name and address of the bidder. All bids shall be sealed and plainly marked "Phoenix Drive Reconstruction".

Bids shall be submitted in **duplicate**, signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Each Bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the Bid and all persons interested therein. Each BIDDER must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends that construction will begin by September 1, 2012 and requires that this project be completed and ready for final payment no later than October 31, 2012.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 shall be required.

Copies of the bid documents and specifications are on file in the office of the City Engineer, 205 South Main Street, Urbana, Ohio 43078, where they may be obtained for a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit for each set of these documents.

Each prospective bidder shall be a plan holder of record with the City of

Urbana Engineer's Office in order to submit a bid for this project.

The contractor and all subcontractors shall pay employees on the project the prevailing wages established by the Ohio Department of Commerce, Bureau of Wage and Hour Administration (614-644-2239) including all updates, and shall comply with the provisions of Chapter 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code. The current Prevailing Wage Rate Schedule is included in the bid documents.

A valid workers' compensation certificate shall be provided upon contract award to the successful bidder. Furthermore, a Drug-Free Safety Program shall be in place with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for the prime contractor and all subcontractors during the life of the project.

A valid certificate of insurance in accordance with the bid documents issued to the City of Urbana shall be provided upon contract award to the successful bidder.

Upon contract award, the successful bidder shall provide current contractor registration with the Champaign County Building Regulations Department for the contractor and any subcontractors. Contractor registration at time of bid submission shall not be required for bid to be considered.

No bids shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive irregularities in any Bid and to accept any Bid which is deemed by the Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
